

Held in Fatal Robbery

Frankie Gustin Accused in \$14,000 Detroit Holdup

Arraigned before Judge William Sullivan in Municipal Court yesterday, **Frank Wallace**, alias Frankie Gustin, of South Boston, was held without bail for hearing Aug. 8 in connection with a \$14,000 holdup and murder at the Detroit News plant last month.

Gustin was remanded to Charles St. jail, and will be held till arrival of extradition papers from Detroit.

His arrest came in the corridor of Municipal Court yesterday, when two witnesses from Detroit pointed him out to officers.

Wallace had just emerged from a court room where he was arraigned in a jewel robbery case when he was spotted by Isabella Richardson, elevator operator, and Frederick Thornton, editorial secretary of the News, who came here with two Detroit police inspectors.

At his arraignment in the other case Wallace was released on bail,

the case being continued. He is charged with larceny.

An attractive South Boston girl in the early 20's, formerly a Newspaper row waitress, and believed to have been with the "Gustin Gang" in Detroit, was being widely sought last night by police of Boston and New York.
